San Carlos' major addresses the call of Industrias Infinito S.A.

Moravia and Chamorro very close to obtaining better roads and electricity

- What could not be done in three months was obtained in two business days

“We are filled with satisfaction”, the general manager of Industrias Infinito S.A. (IISA), Jesus Carvajal, summarized with these words the news that became known yesterday in San Carlos regarding the availability of light trucks to transport the gravel that will make possible the construction of 27,5 kilometers of roads and the electrification of Moravia and Chamorro.

“Will is the key word that has cleared up doubts on the realization of this important project”, Carvajal added and emphasized the prompt answer from the municipal major, Marco Luis Camacho, after IISA had to publicly report last week the non-compliance on the part of the Municipality of an agreement signed on March 12.

Carvajal regretted that Major Camacho had described the issue made public as “a frontal attack” and emphasized that “I have never taken this issue personally and, if I called the Major to account it was because our system establishes so and because, in the end, Mr. Marco Luis is a people's representative”. The manager added that, in this case, IISA was the voice of those who do not have one.

The official also congratulated the new Municipal Council since it did understand the importance of this project for the benefited communities, as they are among the most remote and poorest of the canton.

Social commitment

To IISA, the donation of the 90 million colones in materials from the Crucitas Face for this work is another proof that , together –the company, the neighbors and the municipality – “we will be able to develop in the future a relationship of mutual service and of commitment with the human development.”, Carvajal pointed out.
