Major fails to fulfill agreement signed with Industrias Infinito

San Carlos municipality halts development of isolated communities

- Lack of definition threatens urgent electrification and road plans

Almost three months have passed and San Carlos' Municipality has not yet fulfilled the agreement it signed with Industrias Infinito, proprietor of the Crucitas Project, that will allow the repair of 27.5 kilometers of road and that will make a long awaited project of electrification in Coopelesca feasible.

The agreement that the Bishop of Ciudad Quesada, Angel Sancasimiro, signed as a witness, continues to "dream of justice" at the office of the Municipal Major, Marco Luis Camacho, who has systematically refused to explain the reasons of such non-compliance, the General Manager of Industrias Infinito, Jesus Carvajal, detailed.

Carvajal added that the CONAVI, as well as Coopelesca, have fulfilled the terms of the agreement, but without the municipal support –consisting of the contribution of light trucks- it will not be possible to transport the materials (donated by the Company as part of its policy of human development and good neighbor) from the Crucitas Face.

" We are aware of the concern of Moravia's and Chamorro's inhabitants. However, their dream coming true no longer depends on our company. We have an agreement and the will of CONAVI and Coopelesca. We have provided the materials and the only thing that remains to be done is the fulfillment of the commitment on the part of the Major and the new Council", emphasized the manager and detailed that the contribution of materials alone amounts to, approximately, 90 million colones.

When consulted on this, the community leaders of Moravia and Chamorro, who were also signers on the agreement, indicated that this issue was going to be part of the topics to be addressed together with the social-Christian member of the assembly, German Rojas, in a meeting to be held this coming Friday in Ciudad Quesada.
