Municipal delegation of San Carlos visited the Crucitas Project today

- Industrias Infinito supplied them with extensive information

A delegation of eight representatives from San Carlos Municipality visited the Crucitas Project today to get to know the details of the mining project that the Costar Rican company Industrias Infinito S.A. will develop.

The delegation – integrated by directors, one legal advisor and two municipal officials – traveled around the areas where the mine will be located and specialists supplied them with extensive information on the socioeconomic and environmental benefits of the project.

The municipal representatives received extensive information on the technology to be used in the Crucitas mining project for the destruction of cyanide, a chemical used in the process of gold extraction.

Industrias Infinito's General Manager, Jesus Carvajal, detailed that "we explained to the municipal authorities how the use of a plant for the destruction of cyanide (state of the art technology in the global mining industry) will guarantee the protection of the environment"

Carvajal added that today's meeting is part of the communication policy that Industrias Infinito has with all of the representatives of the society of San Carlos and that it is a demonstration of responsibility with the local government.

"Today, we showed the municipal authorities the reality of our project, so that they would get to know it and have a better criterion on what is going to be a true model of high technology for the protection of the environment and the commitment with human development", Carvajal concluded.
